The Hopkinton Conservation Commission has reviewed the Senior Center Building Committee's petition for a variance to access the proposed Senior Citizen Center via a 40-foot strip off Mayhew Street. The Building Committee has filed an Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation with the Commission and was issued, in 2002, an Order of Resource Area Delineation by the Commission approving the wetland delineation for the site. There are no wetlands located within 100 feet of the proposed Mayhew Street access. Given that fact, the Commission has no objections to that access location relative to wetland impacts. As the Board is aware, the development of that site will require a Notice of Intent filing with the Commission for any work within 100 feet of any wetlands on or off site.
