### **9:00 AM      Board of Appeals Public Meeting**

The Board held a Public Meeting and conducted a site walk at the property of E. L. Harvey & Sons on Wood Street in Hopkinton to view the site for the proposed Materials Recovery & Recycling Facility. The Chairman announced at the commencement of the public meeting that this was not a public hearing, and that "We're not going to accept public comment, and questions should not be asked of the applicant."

Harvey required everyone on the walk, other than Board members, to sign a release form stating they would not bring cameras or audio equipment onto the land or collect samples of dirt, water or other materials from the property.

The tour was lead by Harvey engineer Gerry Cushing. Board members asked just a few questions about the location of buildings and how the company would change parts of the property. The Board was also interested in seeing a piece of land abutting the landfill that the company is leasing from the state. Approximately 15 residents were also in attendance.

At approximately 10:00 AM, Mr. Foster moved to adjourn the public meeting. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
